Programme

EAPCCT's Scientific and Meetings Committee are putting the final touches to the packed scientific programme under the leadership of Lotte Høgberg.

Our pre-congress day (25th May) explores the theme of 'Fundamental and applied studies in poisoning – an overview of their role for the clinical toxicologist' with an impressive roster of speakers from Europe, Sri Lanka and the USA.

The themes for the main congress (26th - 28th May) include

- Coronavirus-19 and toxicology
- Alcohol as a co-ingestant
- Investigation and management of caustic ingestions
- Toxicology 2.0: new tools for data collection, surveillance and education in poisoning
- Drug Formulation and its importance in the poisoned patient

There will also be the annual Louis Roche Lecture, the Young Investigator Prize and the first ever EAPCCT Fellows' sponsored lecture to be given by Professor David Christiani (T.H. Chan Harvard School of Public Health, Boston, USA) on Vaping Associated Lung Injury.

In addition, there will be over 300 poster presentations on the aforementioned themes as well as many others including

- Analytical and Forensic Toxicology
- Epidemiology of Poisoning
- Heavy Metal Poisoning
- Household products and poisoning
- Occupational Poisoning
- Paediatric Poisoning

- Recreational Drugs and NPS
- Toxinology
- Veterinary Toxicology

The posters will be available for view with their associated audio-recordings from 20th May and there will be interactive sessions three times a day for you to discuss their content with the authors directly.
