

INFORMATION CLAUSE REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Dear Sir or Madam,

In accordance with Art. 13 sec. 1 and 2 of the GDPR, we kindly inform you that:

The administrator of your personal data is:

We will process your personal data for purposes related to the implementation of the above-mentioned event (registration, sending organizational information, confirmation of participation in the event).

The processing will take place on the basis of your consent (Article 6 (1) (a) of the GDPR), for the purposes of the law (Article 6 (1) (c) of the GDPR, e.g. for the provision of electronic services) and on the basis of the legitimate interests of the Administrator (Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR, i.e. ensuring the security of electronic services, e.g. sending registration confirmations, storing data for archival purposes and ensuring accountability, i.e. demonstrating that we fulfil our obligations under the law and implementation of the TWINALT Project).

Personal data indicated in the registration form will be processed.

You have the right to access your data, request rectification, deletion or limitation of processing (if it is untrue or out of date), object to its processing (when its processing is based on the legitimate interest of the Administrator or for statistical purposes and the objection is justified by the special situation in which you found yourself), transfer and obtain a copy of the data.

Your personal data will be made available only to persons authorized to provide administrative support for the event and partners implementing the TWINALT Project, i.e. 1. Virje Universiteit Brussel (VUB), 2. Norsk Institutt For Luftforskning Stiftelse Norway (NILU), 3. Universita degli Studi Di Milano IT (UMIL).

Your personal data will not be processed in an automated manner - they will not be profiled. They will not be transferred to third countries and international organizations

Providing personal information is voluntary. The consequence of not providing personal data will be the inability to participate in the organized event.

Personal data will be stored for a period of max. 5 years from the date of registration and for the duration of the implemented TWINALT Project - in accordance with applicable law in this area or until the consent for marketing activities is withdrawn.

The usage of the right to withdraw consent does not affect the processing that took place until the consent was withdrawn. We process your personal data in accordance with this information and in accordance with the relevant provisions on the protection of personal data. In the event of dissatisfaction, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
