The research task is to identify new preventive strategies for the reduction of risk factors associated to chronic degenerative diseases, such as cancer and neurodegeneration.

Her name is associated with original and significant contribution to the development of methods based on biomarker analysis to improve assessment of human early biological response, susceptibility and risk.

The research philosophy is a multidisciplinary approach to problems of preventive and translational medicine.

The work has been published in more than 200 papers in peer-reviewed international journals and book chapters, and has been presented at numerous international meetings. She serves as referee for several peer reviewed journals, she serves as referee for national and international grant proposals. She has extensive experience in organizing national and international meetings. She is an active member of national and international scientific Societies.
